28 Him we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all wisdom, that we may present everyone mature in Christ. 29 For this I toil, struggling with all his energy that he powerfully works within me. 2:1 For I want you to know how great a struggle I have for you and for those at Laodicea and for all who have not seen me face to face, 2 that their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, to reach all the riches of full assurance of understanding and the knowledge of God's mystery, which is Christ, 3 in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

## Paul's "struggle" for the Colossian Church

- 1:28: to present everyone mature/complete/holy/finished in Christ (union with christ).
- 2:2: their hearts may be encouraged.
- 2:2: they be knitted together in love
- 2:2: to reach all the riches of full assurance of understanding and knowledge of Christ.
- 2:4: that they not be deceived by the false teaching of plausible, or fine-sounding, arguments

You foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you? Before your very eyes Jesus Christ was clearly portrayed as crucified. 2 I would like to learn just one thing from you: Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the law, or by believing what you heard? 3 Are you so foolish? After beginning by means of the Spirit, are you now trying to finish by means of the flesh? 4 Have you experienced so much in vain—if it really was in vain?
